



## **School Supply List for 2024-2025**



# Supplies Required for 1st and 2nd Grade

All supplies should be brought to school at Open House or on the FIRST day of school.

#### **Supply List (no need to label):**

- 2 packages of no. 2 pencils (no mechanical pencils please)
- 1 small self-contained pencil sharpener
- 1 large pink eraser
- 1 pair of scissors round tip/safety tip only
- 1 small bottle of Elmer's White School Glue
- 3 BIG glue sticks
- 1 box of colored pencils (Crayola brand works best with most projects.)
- 2 boxes of Crayola crayons (Crayola brand works best with most projects.)
- 1 set of basic Crayola watercolors (Crayola brand provides the best color.)
- 1 box washable markers
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- Antibacterial Wipes/Clorox Wipes
- **Girls**: 1 box Ziploc bags (any size)
- **Girls:** Dixie Cups
- **Boys:** 1 small package of plastic forks & spoons
- **Boys**: 1 package of regular or small sized paper plates
- Afternoon Snack (see note on back)

### Supplies to label with child's name:

- art box to hold all supplies (must fit inside student desk)
- 2 two-pocket folders to use as Take Home folders
- 1 spiral notebook (wide ruled)
- gym shoes are required (no black bottoms, please label)
- backpack (if your child brings lunch to school, please be sure to label their lunch bag)
- **Headphones** Must be headband style and corded, not wireless. Headphones are available for purchase in the office while supplies last.
