Early Childhood Developmental Screening

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A developmental screening is available to resident families of Paris School district, who have children ages 3 through 5 years of age and are not yet enrolled in school. The developmental screening includes a series of activities addressing the following skill areas: listening and thinking, speech and communication, physical coordination, eye-hand coordination, and personal-social development.

The focus of the developmental screening is on a child's potential for learning skills rather than on how many readiness skills are mastered. The results of the developmental screening provides an indication that development is occurring as expected or whether further assessment is required.
